





6"Therefore you shall keep the commandments of the Lord your God, to walk in His ways and to fear Him. <sup>7</sup> For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs, that flow out of valleys and hills; <sup>8</sup> a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive oil and honey; <sup>9</sup> a land in which you will eat bread without scarcity, in which you will lack nothing; a land whose stones are iron and out of whose hills you can dig copper. <sup>10</sup> When you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless the Lord your God for the good land which He has given you.



<sup>18</sup> "And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. <sup>19</sup> Then it shall be, if you by any means forget the Lord your God, and follow other gods, and serve them and worship them, I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish. <sup>20</sup> As the nations which the Lord destroys before you, so you shall perish, because you would not be obedient to the voice of the Lord your God.






